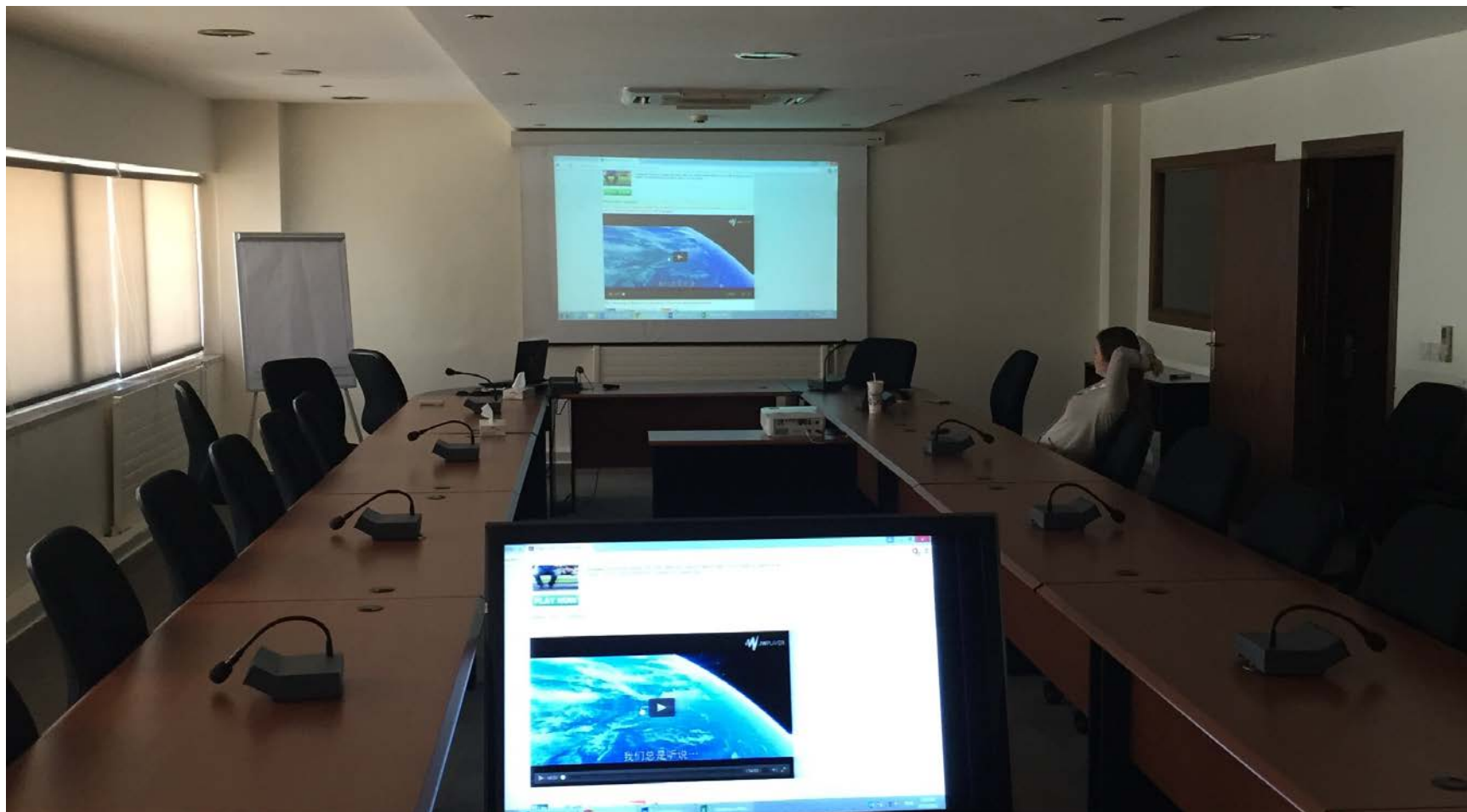

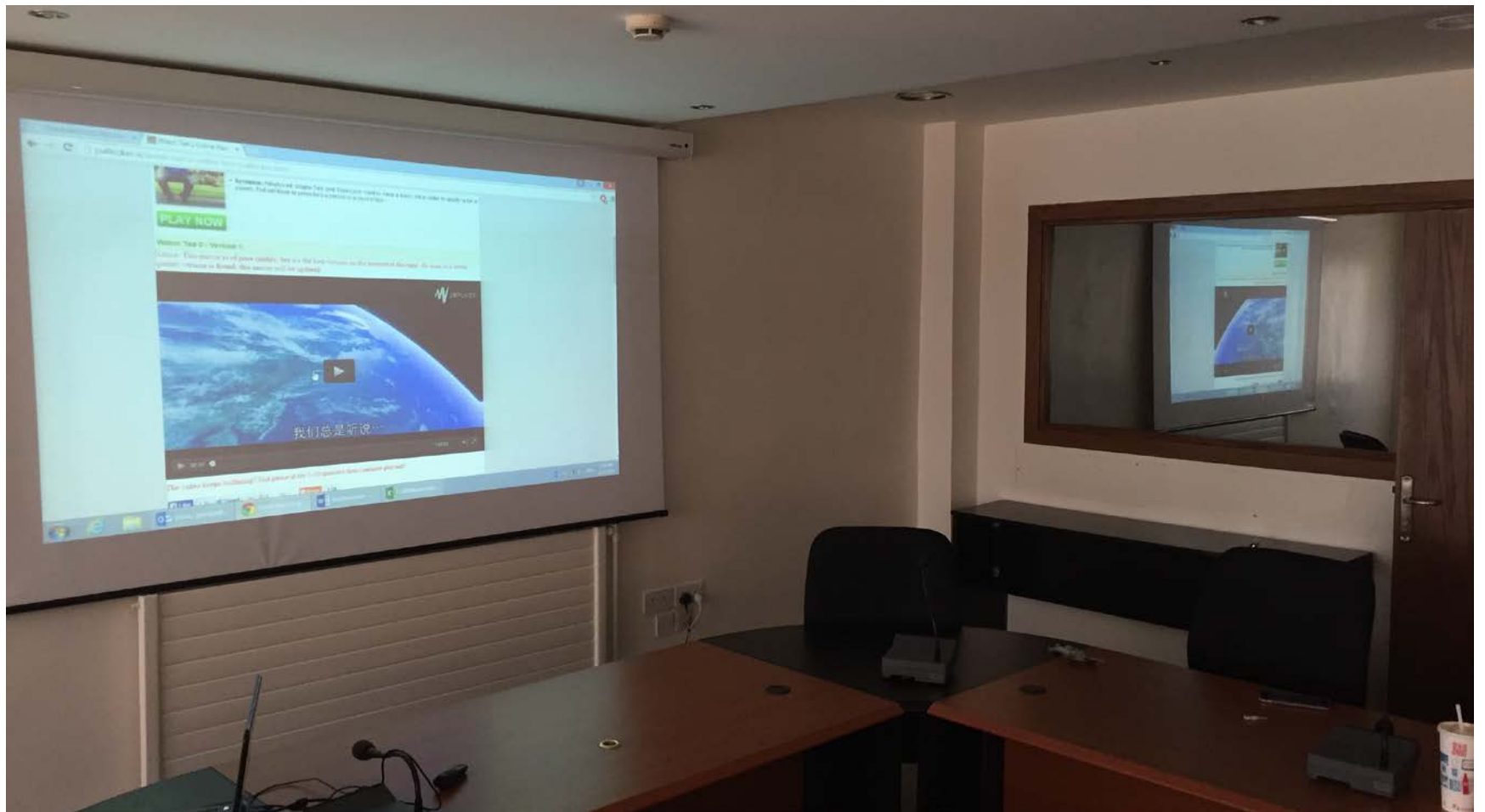
# Work Effect
