

What's Daily NK?

- It merged with three other companies last year into what is now called 'Unification Media Group'
 - They now also broadcast a two-hour radio program to the people in North Korea everyday, to inform them the truth. Which would enlighten the North Koreans, bring about change, and ultimately lead to the reunification of Korea.

What did I do?




- In the beginning, I translated articles from Korean into English, which I thought would be my primary job—but it wasn't.
- Designed the company's English website.
- Started a funding project.
- Wrote an article, advertising a student-led play about defectors and their stories.
- Produced two songs for the company which were also made into music videos.

"The market has been closed for two days now until the 27th due to this incident, which is making people's lives even harder," he explained. "County MPS officials have dispatched local handlers to the region and are holding inminban [people's unit] meetings to ensure this incident or any groundless rumors surrounding it don't spread."

Notably, residents have not raised questions as to why such an incident would have occurred, with many suggesting "something larger needs to happen." Most agree authorities brought the incident upon themselves by cracking down on people during such difficult times, the source reported.

A group of drama students from KoreaNational University of Arts have joined together to put on a play based entirely on the truestories and testimonies of North Korean defe...



How the internship impacted me




- I learned A LOT about North Korea and the inside matters
